

Trmice Castle

The castle was built between 1856 and 1863 in the New-Gothic Tudor style in the castle park by the eminent Bohemian Nostic family. In 1919, the castle was rebuilt by the Ústí industrialist Wolfrum, who later sold it to the city of Ústí nad Labem. In 1994, the castle was reconstructed and now hosts a representative cultural centre with a grand hall and a marble concert hall. It also hosts a permanent exhibition devoted to the history of model railways and a permanent exhibition on the history of mining.

Lake Milada

Lake Milada is the first large-scale water rehabilitation project in the Czech republic. As such, it has become a model for other similar projects in the northwest of Bohemia. Lake Milada has been established as the result of the flooding of the original Chabařovice opencast mine. From 2015 is used by the public for recreational and sports purposes. The northeast beach is mainly designated for bathing and refreshment stands and toilets are open there during the season. The beaches are covered with pebbles (footwear is recommended when entering the water).

The Masaryk Lock (Masarykovo zdymadlo)

Below the Střekov rock, foot-passengers can cross the river to the opposite side of the River Elbe. At the same time, they can see a cultural and technical sight - the waterworks with hydraulic power plant built between 1923 and 1936. The construction was built to make the river navigable. A footpath and the Labská cycle path run above the spillway. On the guided tour you can see the engine room and the spillway control room, the fish transfer lane, the lock chambers can be viewed from the footpath open to the public, and last but not least, you can see the visitors' centre featuring information on the history of the lock and a short video on the construction of the waterworks.

Both routes link up with a nature trail featuring seven information boards.



Waterfalls in the Ústí region

Hardly anywhere will you find so many waterfalls as around Ústí nad Labem. A number of brooks running down to the River Elbe have eroded steep and deep gorges in the sheer slopes of the River Elbe canyon. One of the most famous and visited waterfalls is the Vaňovský Waterfall. Other frequently visited waterfalls are the Průčelský Waterfall in the Průčelská Canyon, a waterfall on the Stříbrnice Creek in the Berta Valley, a waterfall above the Devil's Mill or the more remote Moravian Waterfall.

Střekov Castle

This castle from the early 14th century has always attracted a number of well-known personalities due to its marvellous location in the Bohemian Uplands. Those in awe of the castle included painter Ernst Gustav Doerell, poet Karel Hynek Mácha and worldrenowned composer Richard Wagner, who was inspired to compose his Tannhäuser by the romantic setting of Střekov. Upon request (a group of min. 20 persons) the option of night guided tours with guides in historical costumes.

Church of St. Florian

The Church of St. Florian, a national cultural monument located on the grounds of the Krásné Březno chateau, was built in the Saxon Renaissance style as the private Lutheran Chapel of Our Lady at the turn of the 16th and 17th centuries. Its interior features a ribbed historicist vault with gold-plated rosettes, however, the diamond portals represent a typical feature of the Saxon Renaissance style (not only). The matronea show that the estate's owners - the Knights of Bünau - were Lutheran. The most valuable part of the church's furnishings is a quite unique original main altar with alabaster reliefs uncommonly depicting the genealogy of Jesus Christ as its central theme. The structure

was reconstructed between 2011 and i 2013 and at present is open to the public all-vear-round.

Větruše and the cable car to Větruše

The area of the Větruše castle is an ideal place for your trip. What it can offer:

- A viewing tower with marvellous views of Ústí nad Labem and the River Elbe valley
- Restaurant, hotel, sales of souvenirs
- A mirror maze with funny mirrors and natural maze of green thuja
- Children's corner with climbing frames, tennis courts and multi-purpose pitch
- Two nature trails: Větruše Vrkoč and Větruše Gallows Ústí nad Labem Underground

Ústí residents and visitors have the opportunity to go to the Větruše chateau by cable car. With a length of nearly 350 metres it departs from the roof of the shopping mall in the city centre and connects the centre to the chateau. Each of the two cabins can carry up to fifteen passengers every fifteen minutes. The cable car runs daily except for every first Monday of the month.

Kozí vrch Hill

Kozí vrch Hill is a dominating conical rocky hill situated not far from the municipality of Povrly, with its steep rock face running down to the Elbe River in the south-east direction. From its top, you can enjoy the view towards the Elbe Valley and the Bohemian Uplands. You can see, for example, Dlouhý vrch Hill, Vysoký Ostrý, Milešovka Mountain and Doubravská Mountain, while looking in the opposite direction, you can see Radešín, the Ore Mountains and Blansko. You can reach the Blansko castle ruins from Kozí vrch Hill if you take the green-marked tourist trail. The hill is freely accessible throughout the year.





City Museum in Ústí nad Labem

The museum in Ústí nad Labern dates back to 1876. It currently manages more than 1,100,000 exhibits and collections. The most extensive are numerous natural science collections which document particularly the nature of North West Bohemia, the Bohemian Uplands and the Ore Mountains. The construction work in the historical city centre of Ústí nad Labem in recent decades has expanded the archaeological collections of the museum. The museum also displays collections of warfare, remarkable for a group of arms and military material from the period around 1813, when the famous Battle of Kulm took place nearby. The industrial character of the region is also reflected in the extensive technical collections. There is also a large museum library. Its quality and the volumes of the collections make the City Museum in Ústí nad Labem one of the most important institutions of this type nationwide. For all holidays in the year, the museum has prepared very popular and educational fun programmes for children.

Memorial of Přemysl the Ploughman

In the village of Stadice not far from Ústí nad Labem, you can find the memorial of Přemysl the Ploughman, which has been classified as a national cultural monument

along with the Královský pramen (Royal spring) using which Přemysl the Ploughman used to water his oxen. The memorial with a plough built for Count E. Nostitz-Rieneck was ceremonially unveiled on 3 September 1841. The reliefs created by J. Maxa depict messengers who caught Přemysl the Ploughman ploughing and the scene of Přemvsl arriving in Vyšehrad. On house number 24 situated in the village square of Stadice, you can see a stone plaque informing visitors that Přemysl's farm was originally located there.





Zoo Ústí nad Labem

The Zoological gardens in Ústí nad Labem were created in 1908 as a private bird sanctuary. They were established by a native of Ústí - businessman and keen ornithologist Dr. Heinrich Lumpe. Here you can find a unique collection of animals, featuring more than 200 species. Visitors can take part in a varied accompanying programme, such as an orangutan enrichment programme, feeding Meerkats and sea-calves, honey tree attraction for Malaysian bears, etc. Visitors can also enjoy playgrounds, rest areas, a zoo train and the restaurant and sweetshop. Those interested can also take part in experience programmes. i.e. you can become a breeder for one day, or feed a selected animal yourself.

Back to the setting of the Battle of Chlumec

Between 29th and 30th of August 1813, the hardest battle with the troops of Napoleon in Bohemia, one of the bloodiest of that time, was fought in the vicinity of the villages

Chlumec, Přestanov, Stradov, Žandov and Telnice. Subsequent confrontations culminated in the more major battle of Varvažov fought between 16th and 17th of September 1813, when the troops commanded by General H. Colloredo-Mannsfeld fended off the attack of the French troops led by Emperor Napoleon I. himself. The war events of 1813 are commemorated by several memorials in this area. There is a vellow-marked tourist trail with 12 stops with information boards areas, starting in Přestanov





Velké Březno Castle

One of the newest, smallest and most beautiful castles nationwide. It was not built until between 1843 and 1845 for the then Supreme Burgrave of the Bohemian Kingdom, Count Karel Chotek of Chotkov and Vojnín. The original castle was built in the late Austrian Empire style and rebuilt in the romantic New-Renaissance style at the turn of the 19 th and 20 th century. It is surrounded by a splendid English-style park, unique in the Ústí region, with numerous rare trees and shrubs. The castle hosts interesting events such as exhibitions, concerts and gastrological tastings.

Zubrnice Museum Railway

Visitors can travel on an historic train on the Ústí n. L. Střekov – Velké Březno – Zubrnice line. The railway museum, located on the premises of the Zubrnice railway station, offers a permanent exhibition on the history and present of the Velké Březno – Verneřice – Úštěk railway. Visitors can see old photographs, documents, various "railway" objects, a model railway, a small office with period furnishings and historical speeders. At the Střekov railway station there is also the exhibition of the steam water plant.
